

Local news

In September, the City hosted walks in each of our 30 suburbs with 'Local Convos' that tap into locally-led knowledge and priorities. The walks in the Coastal Ward helped the community connect, chat about local needs and identify priorities.

We heard that vibrant street art and events, activities and community facilities, living near the beach and the ability to walk to local amenities, such as cafes, bars and shopping centres were favourite aspects of residents living in the Coastal Ward.



We also heard how much our community loves getting active along the coast and is interested in improved walkways between beaches without disturbing the natural environment. The City is in the early stages of exploring a proposal for an environmentally-sensitive boardwalk to create an iconic, world-class tourist attraction that will link Perth's best beaches – Scarborough and Trigg. The City is focused on a study to understand the environmental impacts of a potential boardwalk. We will then undertake an economic assessment, develop design options and undertake extensive community consultation.



The Mettams Pool water access ramp replacement was recently completed. Works were jointly funded by \$80,000 from the City of Stirling and \$80,000 from the Department of Transport and Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage (on behalf of the Western Australian Planning Commission) through the CoastWA program.
